MUSTARD HOME: COVID-19 PREVENTION AND CONTROL MEASURES.

1. Policies, Practice and Infrastructure:

-The school has ensured the necessary resources, policies and infrastructure that protect the health and safety of all the learners and the school personnel, including people at higher risk.

2. Behavioural aspects:

- -Learners are being addressed and monitored, considering their age and capacity, to ensure that they respect measures put in place for the prevention and control of COVID-19.
- 3. Hygiene and daily practises at the Boarding Section of the school.
- -Physical distancing at least 1.5 metres between individual beds in the cubicles, and in the dining hall when learners are having their meals.
- -We have ensured adequate and appropriate ventilation in the dormitories with priority for increasing fresh outdoor air by opening windows and doors as much as possible.
- -Hand-washing facilities have been provided with adequate space for social distance.
- -We have ensured the maintenance of clean environment by cleaning of surfaces and shared facilities like toilets; this will be upheld as routine.
- We are continually educating the staff and students on COVID-19 prevention measures with constant guidance on the use of masks.
- 4. Screening and care of sick students, teachers and other staff:
- We are enforcing the policy of "stay-home-if -unwell" and has adopted the option for screening all the staff, parents and learners on arrival at school.

5. Communication with Parents and Students.

We are keeping the parents and students informed about the measures being put in place to ensure their collaboration and support.
